3	<p>Minutes of Previous Meeting Minutes of October 2017 meeting ratified at November 2017 Full Town meeting. No matters arising</p>	
4	<p>Guests Laura told the members that this is her last meeting due to the fact that she will be starting a new job from January 2018. She's also mentioned that Tesco would be having their Christmas market on the 3rd of December with real Christmas trees for sale from 5 – 9pm. Jessica clarified that MODs decision on the area around St Mary's church was a no-go for the Community Garden. Potentially by February to start with land at British Legion and DW is happy to have a word with them. MC suggests to have the land by Manor-Rise housing development as a backup plan and to keep our options open. The request to leave or go on with the up-cycle plant project is pending until funding next March was confirmed. The litter campaign stickers and posters had been cancelled but Jessica will contact the Scouts before Christmas, proposedly Monday the 18th to post up posters.</p>
