Community Centre at 7.00pm

<b>Attended</b> Councillors: H Jones, A Birch, S Dagger, P Hedge, E O’Connell, M Connolly, C Franklin. 2	<b>Declaration of interest</b> Cllr Franklin – Item 3 – sale of old CCTV system.	
3	<b>Minutes of October 2015 ComSvcs meeting had been ratified at the November 2015 full Town meeting.</b> Following on from the issue of the CCTV system being offered for sale on eBay raised at the October meeting, the TC has since spoken to the accountant who had advised that eBay was not an option as there is no TTC eBay account. A request had come in from Knights Tailoring to purchase the CCTV system for £75. Cll’r Franklin advised that Knights may no longer wish to purchase it. C’Ilr Jones proposed that the system be offered for sale at best price on the open market, seconded by C’Ilr Birch, carried.	TC
4	<b>Lambdown Terrace Sign</b> C’Ilr M Connolly advised that at the recent CATG meeting a sign warning of a turning into the small MQ patch at Lambdown Terrace was discussed, cost to be £500. If TTC were in support of such a sign being erected, the £500 would be paid by the CATG. C’Ilr Dagger proposed TTC support the new sign, seconded by C’Ilr Jones, carried.	
5	<b>Community Centre</b> <b>Update</b> – There had recently been an incident of graffiti on the end wall of the Community Centre, those responsible being identified through the CCTV system and their parents contacted. The individuals concerned have now cleaned the graffiti from the wall. <b>Floodlight Quote</b> – A quote of £457 + VAT has been received to install 2 floodlights at either end of the Community Centre. It was questioned whether 3 quotes should have been supplied and the exact location of	



	<p>the lights. It was felt that there was insufficient information available to the meeting so no decision could be taken. Admin was requested to speak to TC and have the matter raised at the next ComEng meeting.</p> <p><b>PAT Test Quote</b> – A quote of £105 + VAT has been received to carry out required PAT testing of 30 items in the Community Centre. <b>C’Ilr Hedge proposed this was accepted, seconded by C’Ilr O’ Connell, carried.</b></p>	<p>GH</p> <p>TC</p>
6	<p><b>Grounds Maintenance</b></p> <p>The rubbish in Drummer lane has not been cleared. Simon Willis at Aspire has been contacted and he will deal with it.</p>	
7	<p><b>Cemetery/Mortuary Chapel</b></p> <p>C’Ilr Birch advised her last group of visitors to the Chapel were very appreciative of TTC taking it on.</p> <p>Grounds were looking very neat and tidy.</p>	
8	<p><b>Town Sign</b></p> <p>TTC is still waiting for the proposed design to be received.</p>	
9	<p><b>SIDS</b></p> <p>C’Ilr M Connolly advised that Graham Wright of Amesbury stated Durrington has already had 2 installed, they are of high spec and training can be given to local council members or nominated members of the public for £200 per person.</p> <p>Ludgershall TC is still deciding whether or not to have 1 installed. TTC has expressed an interest in having 1 installed across 4 locations, but only if costs can be shared with Ludgershall TC. Nothing can move forward on this until Ludgershall TC reaches their decision.</p> <p>C’Ilr Jones questioned whether the costs of having them installed would outweigh the benefit. The meeting agreed the costs would be more reasonable if they could be shared with Ludgershall.</p>	
10	<p><b>Correspondence</b></p> <p>C’Ilr M Connolly circulated the Taking Action on School Journeys document compiled by Clarendon schools requesting provision of bus lay-bys to ease the congestion at drop off and pick up times. 3 options are suggested in the paperwork:</p> <p>Option 1 – Lay-by at Western entrance</p> <p>Option 2 – Lay-by at Northern entrance by corner</p> <p>Option 3 – Bus stop clearway at Northern entrance</p> <p><b>C’Ilr Jones proposed Option 1 as TTC’s preferred option, seconded by C’Ilr Dagger, carried.</b></p> <p>The issue of the parking along the dropped kerbs on Arnotts Close was also included in the correspondence. Again 2 options to try to resolve the matter were suggested:</p>	



	Option 1 – Markings only (“School – Keep Clear”) Option 2 – Formal traffic regulation order to stop parking. C’Ilr Hedge proposed Option 1 as the preferred option, seconded by C’Ilr Birch, carried.	
11	<b>Any other business</b> C’Ilr Hedge reported that the street lights running along the alley way from Drummer Lane pharmacy to the corner of Nadder Road were not working and there have been incidents of vandalism. Admin to report this to the responsible authority and request they be fixed.	GH
