

Pro-Active Work and Incidents Attended

- Pennings's road, Tidworth- Justice Traffic Ticket issued for a vehicle that has been stopped and seized by Police as the driver has not had insurance and has not been supervised by an appropriate person.
- Tidworth Received multiple reports over the last month about riding off road motorbikes on the road to access the nearby woodland paths. This is causing Anti-Social behaviour in the area. Regular patrols being conducted in that area and robust action will be taken by police.
- Tidworth Civic Centre- Two male were seen taking drugs in Tidworth.
 Officer has searched them under section 23 stop and search and seized the small number of drugs from them.
- Spar, Tidworth-Known male suspect has intentionally snapped and broke the Spar flag outside the store, and he has been interviewed under caution. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol Being conducted.
- ASDA Service station, Tidworth- On multiple occasion known Suspects have stolen a crate of Thatcher's from a store, caused Anti-social behaviour and criminal damage in the area. 1 male has been interviewed under caution. They all have been banned from ASDA service station. Enquries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted.
- Wood Park, Ludgershall -Unknown suspects have gained entry to the back garden and opened the shed. Once inside, the suspects have proceeded to steal 3 pedal cycles. Patrols being conducted in the area.
- **Pierce Road, Tidworth-** Unknown three suspects have stolen a vehicle. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted.
- Wylye Road, Tidworth- Unknown suspects has broken into the property, throwing bricks and broken windows. They have also gained entry as the property is vacant- military accommodation. Enquiries are still ongoing. Foot and mobile patrol being conducted by police.
- POP Plan, High Street, Ludgershall Case for POP plan regarding exceeding maximum weight restriction (RC8258). HGVs have been driving straight through the 7.5t weight limit coming so close to the properties that they have caused the houses to shake. POP Plan on going.
- Local officers have stopped the vehicle suspected of being involved in the hare coursing.



- Manor Farm, Collingbourne Kingston-Unknown males have been seen driving on land twice in two weeks. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted in area.
- Andover road, Recreation ground, St James street Ludgershall- Group of youth have seen late night playing loud music, swearing and shouting causing Antisocial behaviours in the area. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted late at night around that area.
- Salisbury plain- We've received reports of motorcyclists and 4x4 vehicles using the byways and bridleways in Ludgershall, Upper Chute and Salisbury Plain, patrols being conducted in area.



Community Engagement

- Local neighbourhood officers have conducted foot patrols around Tidworth and spoke to the local shops and discussed their concerns for following the reports of thefts, ASB and criminal damage.
- Local neighbourhood officers have conducted foot patrol of Ludgershall for following the report on ASB and drug activities in the area.



 Local officers held the community consultation in Ludgershall and engaged with the local community, discussed their concerns and crime prevention advice been given. Gathered intel.



Speed Enforcement

Tidworth:

Speed Enforcement caught 58 vehicles speeding on 4 August 2025 in Tidworth near Ashdown Terrace, over the course of around 50 minutes.

This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was captured travelling at 46mph. On the day in question, it was overcast with occasional showers and roads were wet.

Depending on previous convictions and history: -

53 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course

5 drivers will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.

Speed Enforcement caught 24 vehicles speeding on 19 August 2025 in Tidworth, near Ashdown Terrace, over the course of around 30 minutes.

This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was captured travelling at 46mph. On the day in question, it was overcast, and roads were dry. Traffic was comparatively light for the area.

Depending on previous convictions and history: -

22 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course

2 drivers will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

Ludgershall:

Speed Enforcement caught 3 vehicles speeding on 4 August 2025 in Ludgershall on the Andover Road. Unfortunately, the site on Tidworth Road couldn't be used due to a brokendown vehicle.

This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicles were captured travelling at 38mph. On the day in question, it was overcast, and roads were damp from previous rain.

Depending on previous convictions and history, 3 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course.

Speed Enforcement caught **7** vehicles speeding on 19 August 2025 in Ludgershall, on the Tidworth Road.

This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was captured travelling at 45mph and seemed quite surprised that the speed limit was being enforced. On the day in question, it was overcast, and roads were dry. Traffic was comparatively light for the area.

Depending on previous convictions and history: -

6 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course 1 driver will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

Enford

Speed Enforcement caught 4 vehicles speeding on 4 August 2025 in Enford near The Old Vicarage. I also visited the site near Little cot Mill, but due to construction work taking place there, I could not enforce.

The A345 near The Old Vicarage has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was captured travelling at 42mph. On the day in question, it was bright, and roads were dry.

Depending on previous convictions and history, 4 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place

Collingbourne Ducis

Speed Enforcement caught 8 vehicles speeding on 4 August 2025 in Collingbourne Ducis near the Everleigh Road.

This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was captured travelling at 44mph. On the day in question, it was overcast, and roads were damp from previous rain.

Depending on previous convictions and history: -

6 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course

2 drivers will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

- Regular reassurance foot patrols of Ludgershall for following the reports of ASB and thefts.

- Ongoing reassurance patrol of Salisbury Plain for following the reports of ASB.
- Regular reassurance patrol of Netheravon for following the report of ASB.
- Regular reassurance patrol of Everleigh for following the report of unknown youth set the fire to the portable toilets.
- Regular marked vehicle patrols targeting Rural Crime, Poaching, Fuel theft, Hare Coursing in Enford farm, COLLINGBOURNE DUCIS Farms, COLLINGBOURNE KINGSTON farms, Everleigh farms, Netheravon and Haxton farm, Enford farm, Gammon Farm.
