Pro-Active Work and Incidents Attended

- ASB and criminal damage in Tidworth Leisure centre Multiple reports
 received about group of youths are coming in and out of the Leisure Centre using
 the fire escape and causing the ASB, Criminal damage. Enquiries are still
 ongoing. Action taken by police so far: -
 - 1. Regular patrols been conducted by police
 - 2. CCTV been recovered from Leisure centre
 - 3. Email has been sent about partnership meeting to Council, Military and Aspire so can discuss the concerns regarding anti-social behaviour.
 - 4. Advice been given to leisure Centre about 999
- Preventing Anti-Social Behaviour in Our Community letter been delivered to the parents of children involved in Anti-social behaviour in Tidworth and Ludgershall by local neighbourhood police.
- Halloween-Section 35 Dispersal Orders have been used to manage the antisocial behaviour locally when incidents have occurred and these have been effective. Regular patrol being conducted.



Davide Way, St James Street Ludgershall and surrounded area of Ludgershall
 -Multiple reports have seen where unknown group of kids were out in the street screaming and shouting causing ASB in Ludgershall. Children were identified and WOA advice has been given to parent and children. Regular patrols being conducted in the area.

- **Ludgershall** A known male was found guilty of a dangerous driving and has been given an immediate ban from driving.
- **OP LAZURITE-** Ongoing regular reassurance patrol for those settled and transient member of the local Afghan community residing in locality as part of the op LAZURITE relocation program.
- **Station Road, Tidworth-** Known male has been charged for drink driving offences. Patrol being conducted in the area.
- Salisbury Road, Netheravon-: Unknown suspect has forced open the van's back doors and stolen a battery power grinder. Patrol being conducted
- Netheravon Unknown suspect has cut a hole in the perimeter fence and gained access to the site. suspect has then damaged 5 containers, forcing off the lock and looking inside. Nothing taken as most items are too bulky. There was no CCTV available in the area. Patrol being conducted.
- Station Road Tidworth- Rider has been seen riding an e-scooter. Upon stopping
 was unable to produce insurance etc. Vehicle seized s165. Patrol being
 conducted.



• **Tidworth leisure Centre-** Unknown group of youths are coming in and out of the Leisure Centre using the fire escape and causing the ASB, enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted in the area.

- Aughton Collingbourne Kingston- unknown suspect(s) have cut chains and gas hose and then stolen 2 large orange gas cannisters from the side of reporting person's house. Patrol being conducted in the area.
- Halloween- Group of youth has been seen causing the ASB in Tidworth on Halloween night and Sec 35 dispersal order was placed by police to disperse the youth for 24 hours.
- McEvoy Garden, Ludgershall An unknown male has stolen the parcel from reporting person's front door that delivered by post man. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted.
- **Hare Coursing -**There has been increased of the hare coursing in the local area of Enford, Everleigh, Collingbourne Kingstone and Collingbourne Ducis, Ludgershall. Neighbourhood team along with rural crime officer regularly patrolling the area.



Netheravon – Multiple reports has been seen recently regarding the wanted male in Dorset is in Netheravon, we can confirm that it's not the wanted male and police are regularly conducting the reassurance patrols of Netheravon for that matching description unknown male. Police have been to the Sainsbury to check the CCTV the time provided by reporting person, however nothing noted on that time.  the road show with mobile police station where they spoke to the community of
 Enford, Netheravon, Collingbourne Ducis, Ludgershall, Tidworth and It was great
 to speak that did visit for a general chat, about topic and issue in the community.
 Crime prevention advice has been given. Gathered the intel.



 Local neighbourhood officers have conducted foot patrol of Ludgershall for following the report of ASB and drug activities in the area.



• Local officer has attended the Enford firework where the office of Police crime Commissioner for Wiltshire and Said hello. Engaged with the Enford community



- Local neighbourhood officers regularly doing the foot patrol of clarendon school Tidworth and Wellington Academy. Engaged with the parents and children.
- Local officer along with Early intervention team has attended the Wellington Eagle school to discuss the mini police for this year and engaged with the children.

Speed Enforcement

• Tidworth:

Speed Enforcement caught 28 vehicles speeding on 16 October 2025 in Tidworth on Park Road.

This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was captured travelling at 45mph. On the day in question, it was overcast, and roads were dry. Traffic was reasonably light for the area and the time of day, but bottlenecks were occurring due to the passage of vehicles bearing wide loads that were accompanied by escort vehicles. While this was happening, a worrying number of drivers were observed failing to read the road ahead and to adjust their speed to the conditions.

Depending on previous convictions and history: -

26 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course

2 drivers will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

• Collingbourne Kingston

Speed Enforcement caught 3 vehicles speeding on 16 October 2025 in Collingbourne Kingston near the layby to the south of the village. This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was captured travelling at 45mph. On the day in question, it was overcast, and roads were dry. It was also surprisingly quiet for the time of day – for information, enforcement took place around 09:00.

Depending on previous convictions and history: -

2 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course

1 driver will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

Netheravon- Speed enforcement session 23/10/2025 in Netheravon at the A345
 Salisbury Road and 3 vehicles have been issued with notices of intended
 prosecution for excessive speeding.

The roads monitored are 40 MPH and the fastest vehicle was captured at 49 MPH

Depending on previous convictions and history

3 Drivers will be offered a speed awareness course or face £100 fine and 3 Points

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place, which includes checking for MOT, Insurance & Point Totters.

Captured footage will be analysed for other offences like seat belts and mobile phone use.

• Ludgershall- Speed Enforcement caught 4 vehicles speeding on 16 October 2025 in Ludgershall on the Tidworth Road.

This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicles were captured travelling at 37mph. On the day in question, it was bright, and roads were dry.

Depending on previous convictions and history, all 4 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

Priority Patrols

- Regular reassurance foot patrols of Ludgershall for following the reports of ASB and thefts.
- Regular reassurance foot patrols of Tidworth for following the report of theft, criminal damage and ASB.
- Ongoing reassurance patrol of Wood Park, Ludgershall, Tidworth Upper Chute and Salisbury for following the report of ASB in the area.
- Ongoing reassurance patrol of Salisbury Plain for following the reports of ASB.
- Regular marked vehicle patrols targeting Rural Crime, Poaching, Fuel theft, Hare Coursing in Enford farm, COLLINGBOURNE DUCIS Farms, COLLINGBOURNE KINGSTON farms, Everleigh farms, Netheravon and Haxton farm, Enford farm, Gammon Farm.



Numerous other activities have been carried out, which cannot be disclosed for operational reasons
