3	<b>Minutes of Previous Meeting</b> Minutes of May 2017 meeting ratified at June 2017 Full Town meeting. No matters arising	
4	<b>Guests</b> AJ came along to the meeting to update the members on how the festival was coming along and answer any questions. He confirmed that all acts were now booked and there was lots of free entertainment throughout the day. There will be a full team brief on the day at 11.30am. Jessica reported that all entries for the litter campaign had been received. St Mary's is looking promising as the site for the Community Garden. DW raised concerns that the location may be a bit far out for those who do not drive, however wherever the location this would probably be an issue. DW has volunteered to be part of a working group. Laura informed the members that Tesco will be holding a Community Day on 20 <sup>th</sup> August 2017, 10am-3pm. Pitches are £10.00 to be donated to charity.	
5	<b>Riverbourne Fields Playpark</b> Two of the three requested designs have been received. The Clerk has been promised the final one by 24 <sup>th</sup> June 2017. The members discussed how best to consult with the public. It was agreed that the designs should be displayed in the Community Centre. The Clerk also suggested an open evening at the Wellington Primary as this would be a captive audience. She will make contact with the school to see if this is viable. AD is keen for an online survey to be carried out. The members feel that the survey will need to be more in depth than the standard free Survey Monkey which is available. <b>BP proposed that no more than £30.00 is spent on purchasing an online survey, seconded by MC, carried.</b>
