He is unable to book a band and asked if the Council could help. 	<p>Planning Committee next month.</p> <p>Himself and AC have attended a meeting to discuss the revised plans for the Civic Centre and agree there are improvements. The parking is now to be 68, 11 of which are to be disable. He has met with one of the partners to discuss viability and funding. MC has made it clear that TTC's budget is £4 million plus £250,000.00 for furnishing and equipment.</p> <p>He said how fantastic the art work on the Queens Wall was and explained that the idea originated from him being approached by a lady in Ludgershall he then got the Area Board to fund the scheme. Along with SF and the Clerk he has been discussing TTC arranging a similar project for the end of the Community Centre which needs repairing. Due to unforeseen circumstance the opening of Connolly Way playpark has been delayed, the Clerk has today received the inspection and there are issues which need to be addressed.</p> <p>MC ended his report by saying that the festival was the best yet and he passed on his thanks to all involved especially SF and the Engagement Committee, all Councillors who help on the day, AJ Mayhew and his team and TTC's staff.</p>
