Grounds Maintenance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pedestrian Crossing Requests <p>MC clarified the different costs of pedestrian crossings and also the price of the initial assessment which is about £1000 to £1500 depending of the on the length of road to be investigated. The Town Council is expected to pay a 25% contribution.</p> <p>The Committee discussed three requests for new crossings within Tidworth. These are the junction of Ludgershall Road with Beech Hill Road, the brow of the hill on Pennings Road, and Bulford Road near the junction with Kohat Road.</p> <p>MC put forward the motion that Pennings Road, for safety reasons, to be in more need of a crossing. A 25% contribution towards the initial investigation on Pennings Road was proposed by HJ, seconded by DK, carried.</p>	AN/Town Clerk
