MC has done extensive work calculating predicted figures for 2021/22 taking into consideration the reduced tax base (about 3%). The members discussed the option of 5%, 7.5%, 9% and 10%. They are mindful of the impact Covid will have in general but are aware that the Civic Centre project must continue. MC proposed that the precept demand for 2021/2022 be £474,252. This will mean a £1.17 monthly rise to Band D
