Allotments</b> Still awaiting scope of work and estimates from ground Maintenance Contractor, CL will chase this as work will need to commence soon if the allotments are to be ready for the next season. Notice will need to be given on the current grazing leases for work to commence so this will need to be done sooner rather than later. <b>LC proposed that after August full town meeting, notice period to vacate the paddocks is calculated and issued, seconded by CW, carried.</b></p>
